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PRESENTATION

The Brazilian Academy of Management (ANPAD) in collaboration with the Public Management Research Association (PMRA) are pleased to invite you to the Academic Writing Workshop within the 47th ANPAD Annual Meeting - EnANPAD 2023.

PMRA is one of the most active academic networks in the Public Administration field. PMRA is a nonprofit academic membership association that furthers research on public organizations which over the years has substantially increased in size and influence. The Public Management Research Association Conference has become the foremost gathering of leading public management scholars in the US and around the world. PMRA publishes the *Journal of Public Administration Research and Theory* (JPART), one of the premier journals in the field, and *Perspectives on Public Management and Governance* (PPMG), which debuted in 2017.

The Brazilian Academy of Management (ANPAD) is the leading national association of graduate programs, research groups, and researchers in Administration, Accounting, and related fields. It has been operating since 1976 and brings together 104 graduate programs and more than 2,000 members from all over Brazil. Each year, ANPAD organizes three divisional meetings and one general meeting representing the 11 research groups of our community. In addition, ANPAD publishes two leading academic journals – the *Journal of Contemporary Administration* (RAC) and *BAR – Brazilian Administration Review*, and one referenced database of scientific content (Spell). Also, it is responsible for Teste ANPAD, a nationwide used proficiency test for graduate programs.

The Workshop will grant R\$1,000 (one thousand Brazilian Reais) for each of its 16 participants.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Workshop participant selection will be competitive since there are only 16 available slots. Academics at the early and mid-career stages are welcome to apply to the workshop. Advanced doctoral students (in the dissertation writing stage), doctoral fellows, and junior faculty from Brazil of Latin American origin, or based in Latin America or the Global South, are particularly encouraged to apply. The selection of applications for the workshop will be based on the completeness and quality of their application.

Applicants must send:

- A SHORT COVER LETTER (max. 2 pages) outlining why you want to attend the workshop and your research interests.
- A CURRICULUM VITAE
- A MANUSCRIPT in English you already have prepared or an ABSTRACT of a manuscript in English that will be completed for submission by mid-September 2023.
